Report on Webinar 'Pandemic and Literature'

The Department of English, Shrirkrishna Mahavidyalaya, had successfully organised a webinar on 'Pandemic and Literature.' It took place on August 5, 2020. Dr. Sudhir Nikam (Chairman of the Board of Studies, University of Mumbai, Mumbai), inaugurated the webinar. In his inaugural speech, he focused on the concept of pandemic literature and the challenges of teaching methods, and he commended the excellence of Shrikrishna Mahavidyalaya Gunjoti; how the Mahavidyalaya has been constructed for the deprived classes of society and how it has created a new momentous in the rural region. Prof. Uttam Ambhore (Chairman of the Board of Studies, and Head of the Department of English, Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathwada University, Aurangabad) was a guest of honour of the program.
